The Australian Museum is a Sydney icon, established in 1827, offering a selection of extraordinary venues combined with a superior level of personal and professional service. Located across from Hyde Park, the Museum is a beautiful sandstone building perfect for cocktails, dinners, conferences, product launches and workshops.

The Foyer with its soaring colonial ceilings, grand staircase and enormous whale skeleton is ideal for a sit down dinner for 150 people or a cocktail party for 300 people.



Skeletons Gallery is home to over 100 skeletons! The dark timbers and theatrical double height ceiling provide an entrancing experience. The gallery accommodates up to 84 guests for a sit down dinner or 120 guests for a cocktail event.



The Terrace offers a simple elegance and uninterrupted views across Hyde Park to Sydney's CBD. This space is extremely versatile as it can be used both throughout the day and evening. The luxurious space can be used for sit down dinners, cocktails, corporate presentations, seminars, lectures, product launches and weddings. It can seat 110 guests or stand 200 guests for a cocktail event.

The Atrium has a glass roof suspended 20metres above the floor capturing the ambient daylight or reflecting the dramatic lighting at night. This spectacular room can cater for cocktail events of up to 250 guests.



Albert Chapman Mineral Collection contains Australia's largest mineral collection and its contemporary design creates an intimate space for cocktail events of up to 120 guests.
