The **Great Hall** located within Sydney University has over 150 years of history and grace within its walls. Designed by Edmund Blacket, this spectacular venue has old world charm, with its high ceilings, arched entranced and stained glass windows at either end of the Hall (meant to symbolise Cambridge and Oxford Universities).

The Hall can seat up to 350 guests for Dinner and can hold up to 600 guests for a Cocktail Party. The surrounding grounds are perfect for pre-dinner drinks and as the ideal backdrop for wedding photos.



The **MacLaurin Hall**, built in 1909, was once the original library reading room of the University, and was converted into a special event venue in 1963. Situated adjacent to The University Quadrangle, The Hall seats 400 people for lunch and dinner events and up to 600 people for cocktail receptions. The Nicholson Museum, situated directly below MacLaurin Hall is delightful as a pre-dinner drink or cocktail area.

The University of Sydney is the ideal venue for hosting conferences, cocktail receptions, wedding reception or formal gala dinners. The venue is close to public transport and onsite parking can be arranged
